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

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Absences and Attendance

Absences

Attendance is important at GIBI. Most of our classes are three to five weeks per month, it is impossible to receive the full benefit of the teaching unless the student is in attendance <u>faithfully</u>. If for some reason you must be absent, all work missed due to absence must be made up within a two week period if credit is to be received. If a student is tardy for three classes, it will be counted as one day's absence and will result in a drop in student's final grade.

Withdrawals and Course Changes

Withdraws can only be made within the first two weeks of class. All withdraws must be submitted in writing to the Administrator.

A student who drops a class during the first two weeks of the course, or drops a course with passing grades after the first two weeks, and has notified the administrator will receive a grade of "W". If a student withdraws after the first two weeks of the course and is not earning a passing grade, will be issued a grade of "F".





Explanation of Ministry License

License Renewal

Ministerial Licensing is valid for one year from the date of presentation. License renewal through ICALM can be obtained for an annual fee. License renewal eligibility is at the strict discretion of the Presiding Bishop of ICALM and the ICALM Membership Committee, based upon the fruit of your ministry. ICALM reserves the right to deny recertification if the current standard of ministry is compromised or unbefitting our representation and recognition in the community. It is the responsibility of the licensee to complete and return the renewal form with fee prior to the expiration date. Licensee will be notified 30-60 days in advance of expiration date.

Full Pastoral Ordination, The Next Step

After the presentation of your ministry license, you will be sharpened and honed by the practical use of your general ministerial license for a minimum of 2 years, preparing you for the next step... Pastoral Leadership.

Upon completion of 128 credits, up to four years of <u>documented ministerial practical training/experience</u>, and with all required courses and favorable recommendation from your senior pastor you may become eligible for Ordination through ICALM or you may consider ordination through your home church. This higher calling into ministry involves every aspect of the training you will receive here at GIBI. We honor God's calling on each individual; therefore, evaluation for this spiritual promotion is considered very seriously by the pastoral leadership and faculty.

ALL STUDENTS BEING CONSIDERED FOR ICALM ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE A PRACTICAL MINISTRY TRAINING FORM DOCUMENTING CHURCH OR MINISTERIAL INVOLVEMENT, ASK FOR ONE AT TIME OF REGISTRATION.



Degree Programs: Master of Theology

Master of Theology Degree

After having Graduated with a bachelor's degree students will need an additional 36 Credits (for a total of 164 credits) to meet the requirements of the master's degree. The additional courses required for the masters degree may be selected from any courses not previously taken. In addition a thesis consisting of a minimum of 25,000 words of double-spaced typewritten pages is required. Title and content for each thesis must be approved by the Administration before you begin. Thesis deadlines for graduating students are as follows: Preliminary thesis due by March 18. The thesis must be submitted in APA (American Psychological Association) format. Purchase the 6th (7th after June 2021) edition of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association. Additionally you may want to purchase a copy of the book "Writing Your Dissertation in Fifteen Minutes a Day" by Joan Bolker, ED.D. The thesis review fee is \$50.00 and payable at the time the thesis is submitted to the institute.

Degree Programs: Doctor of Theology

Doctor of Theology Degree

After having Graduated with a master's degree students will need an additional 36 Credits (for a total of 200 credits) to meet the requirements of the doctorate degree. The additional courses required for the master's degree may be selected from any courses not previously taken. In addition a dissertation consisting of a minimum of 50,000 words of double-spaced typewritten pages is required. Content for the dissertation must be approved by the administration before you begin. Dissertation deadlines for graduating students are as follows: Preliminary dissertation due by March 1. The Dissertation must be submitted in APA (American Psychological Association) format. Purchase the 6th (7th after June 2021) edition of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association. For complete details of the dissertation requirements each student must purchase a copy of the book "Writing Your Dissertation in Fifteen Minutes a Day" by Joan Bolker, ED.D. The dissertation review fee is \$100.00 and payable at the time the dissertation is submitted to the institute.

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Explanation of Ministry License

General Ministerial Licensing, the First Step

When all required studies and additional courses totaling 64 credits are completed in the allotted time, with up to two years practical training records, and a recommendation for licensing by both your senior pastor and the GIBI Chancellor, you may become eligible to receive your General Ministerial License. This license entitles you to perform all duties regulated by your local government. Such as: Marriages, Burials, Memorials, Communion, Baptisms, etc.

This license will be issued through International Covering Alliance & Licensing for Ministries, hereinafter referred to as ICALM is a Full Gospel Spirit-filled Apostolic Prophetic Ministerial network with members from coast to coast and in various parts of the world. Being a full gospel Spirit-filled fellowship, our affiliate members are comprised of those individuals with Evangelical Pentecostal Charismatic backgrounds and experience.

ICALM is a medium through which those of like mind, heart, and faith may work harmoniously together for the promotion of the Gospel of Jesus Christ around the world. We believe that *everybody* is *somebody* and every ministry that is of God is important to God and for the benefit of all mankind.

Among the purposes and goals of ICALM is to assist and mentor all those called to Christian ministry through an *organized*, *reputable apostolic prophetic network* thereby promoting *INTEGRITY*, CREDIBILITY and ACCOUNTABILITY. Our I.C.A.L.M. motto is: Covering Without Control Affiliation Without Assimilation Community With True Unity.

Evaluation of Ministerial Experience

Ministerial experience credits may be awarded to GIBI applicants, especially Licensed and Ordained Ministers. Ministerial experience credit is a maximum award of up to 12 units for lay workers and a maximum award of up to 30 units for Licensed and Ordained Ministers. The evaluation of a ministerial resume, certificates of completion, diplomas, awards, etc. determines the amount of credit awarded.

Example:

Students entering any of the GIBI bachelor's degree programs may be awarded *up to 30 units* of ministerial experience for *8 years of full-time Senior Pastor experience or its equivalent*, or *up* to 30 units of ministerial experience for *12 years of full-time Associate Pastor ministry or its equivalent*.

Ministerial experience credit may also be awarded to elders, deacons and Christian workers. This credit is reviewed on an individual basis and is a maximum award of up to 12 units.

In no case shall the maximum number of credits for ministerial experience granted exceed 30 units for any student.

Ministerial Experience Fees

Students receiving ministerial experience credits are required to pay a tuition fee of \$35.00* per credit awarded. For example, 30 units of ministerial experience credits will equal \$1,050.00 of tuition fees. These credits are for training or ministry involvement that has taken place prior to enrolling at GATEWAY INTERNATIONAL BIBLE INSTITUTE and can be In-Church or Outreach Ministries. Certification Program: Chaplaincy

Chaplaincy Training Program

The community is advancing in their chaplaincy requirements and standards are increasing every day. As the requirements increase so does the opportunity to earn an income between 30-60,000 + per year if you work full time.

The Chaplaincy Training program consists of two levels.

Chaplaincy Training Program Cont.

Level 2= Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) Unit Training.

- i. Not everyone will qualify or be interested in the CPE Unit Training. It is necessary if you want to be in full-time chaplain in areas like Hospice, etc.
 - 1. One unit has 9 modules which includes reflections papers didactic reading, case studies and lectures.
 - 2. To be able to complete the 9 modules you must have a clinical position or volunteer in a chaplaincy type clinical setting to be able to apply and evaluate your experiences.
- ii. For CPE the student must have a Bachelor's Degree or greater in Theology from an accredited college and ordination and licensing credentials.
 - 1. Minimum of 2 years ministerial experience or applicable professional experience.
- iii. There are a total of 4 units of CPE training to complete (2 units will help your consideration for a position).

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Advance Standing

Advance Standing

Students who have completed courses in institutions other than GIBI or have ministerial experience in the local church may receive credit for their work. This requires a submission of official transcripts, certificates, diplomas, and/or a ministerial resume to the administrator for evaluation.

College Transcripts and Credit

A student who submits his college transcript to this Administration will receive credit for his prior training where it is applicable to the curriculum at GIBI. Credit transfers are at the discretion of the administrator.

Evaluation of Theological and Non-Theological College Courses

Students having earned college credit in fields other than theology may receive up to 60 units of advanced standing in GIBI for general education. This placement is determined by the evaluation of official transcripts submitted by the requesting student and endorsed by the administrator. All students requesting a review of transfer materials will be assessed a one time fee of \$100.00. Transferring courses must have a GPA of 2.0 or more. Grades of D or below will not be accepted in transfer. GIBI supports forward learning therefore review of credits from other institution must be done in the first degree assessment at GIBI.

<u>Please Note:</u> A tuition fee of \$35.00* per credit applies to all Advance Standing Credits including; College Transfers, Ministry Training Courses and Ministry Experience.



Admission Procedures

Entrance Requirements

A one time Application/Enrollment fee of \$80.00 per student will be charged and payable at the time the Student Application is submitted. The only entrance requirement at GIBI is that students seeking a degree be able to complete homework assignments in a timely manner. There cannot be a set standard in this area since it depends upon the willingness of the student to discipline himself in study habits. Therefore, it remains a case-by-case judgment by the Administration with the best interests of the student in mind. Currently we request that homework for attended classes be turned in no later than two weeks following the final session.

Registration

Registration forms for enrollment at GIBI are available at the college office, or may be obtained by visiting our website at www.gibionline.org or upon request. Office hours are Tuesday—Wednesday 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM & Thursday 1:00 PM to 6:00 PM. We encourage students to register *at least* one week prior to the starting date of each new course. Please call ahead for an appointment, since hours can vary.
